S. With reference to my letter of the 20th instant respecting the Lighter "SERVICE SHELL VI", I beg to acquaint you the Committee have had before them at their meeting to-day a First Entry Report from the Society's Surveyor at Rouen and that the vessel has been classed as Local Barge, For River and Estuary Services subject to the handle of the drain cock at the O.F. service tank being weighted in order that the cock may be self-closing and to valves being fitted on the discharge pipes at the ship's sides. Notations of "Carrying Oil Fuel in Bulk, F.P. above 150°F" and Lloyd's A & CP have also been assigned.
