Dear Sir,

Further to my letter of the 30th ultimo respecting the Steamer "TAQUARY", I have to acquaint you that the Owners have today informed me that they regret they are unable at present to complete the repairs recommended in connection with the Second Special Survey No.2, as the vessel is required to take the place of the steamer "GURUPY" which is in urgent need of repairs, but that they confidently expect to be able to lay her up again in about six months time and that the remainder of the repairs will then be carried out.

The Owners further say that they trust the vessel will be eligible to be reinstated in her original class when the repairs have all been satisfactorily completed.
