The case of the above-named ship has received the consideration of the Committee today in the light of your letter of the 21st instant.

In reply, I have been authorised to say that provided you are completely satisfied after a General Examination of this vessel, the Committee will be agreeable to the Special Survey being deferred until January 1963 as desired by the Owners. It will also be in order for you to issue a short term Load Line certificate with a similar validity, provided the requisite Load Line Survey is held.

As regards the machinery, the Continuous Survey of the engines should be advanced and your inspection should include an examination of port main engine No.5 unit and starboard main engine Nos. 6 top and bottom ends.

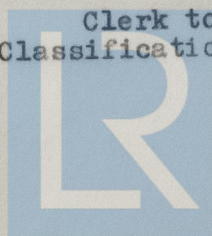
I am asked to add that, bearing in mind the age of the ship, the Committee rely on your exercising particular care in carrying out your inspection.
