Dear Mr. Carey,

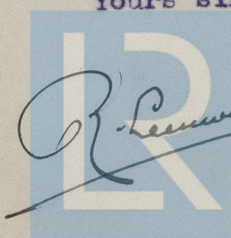
In reply to your letter of yesterday's date regarding the plans of the motor vessel "ALDEGONDA", as built, I beg to state that the plans after which the vessel has been built are in your possession. I am sorry if my letter of the 4th instant was not clear on that point, but what was meant to convey in that letter was that the plan which has been passed in this Office and which is stamped and dated 13/2/30 with Mr. Lodder's initials, is the plan after which the vessel has been built and after which the first entry certificate can be prepared.

I may also state that the motor vessel "HALIOTIS", Messrs. Rykee & Co's No. 202, and Rotterdam Report No. 20252, which was forwarded yesterday, has also been built after this plan.
