CLASSING LETTER

10866 "PENELOPE". As recommended, except that class has been continued subject, inter alia, to indented shell plates Nos.4 and 5 in third below sheerstrake with framing in way (port side forward) being specially examined and dealt with as necessary by the Special Survey.

10864 "LEMONIA" (ex "ANNA MARIA"). As recommended, except that a fresh record of SS 3.64 has not been assigned pending completion of the CSM.

According to records in this Office the main engine Nos.3, 4, 5 and 6 cylinders, pistons, valves and gears, connecting rods, top ends and guides have not been seen for more than four years and arrangements should be made for these items to be dealt with at an early date.

"AGHIOS NICHOLAOS". I shall be glad to have a reply to my Classing Letter dated 26th March and to know how this case now stands.
