This ship was built by FORGES AND CHANTIERS DE LA MEDITERRANEE, LA SEYNE in 1960-04 and classed:-

Messrs. W.F.HENRY VAN SER ZEE & CO N.V., in their letter dated 10.04.64, advised that this "Bulgarian" vessel has been withdrawn from L.R. Class.

A Notation of "CLASS WITHDRAWN AT OWNERS' REQUEST" was assigned per Committee Minute dated 24.04.64.

The Piraeus Surveyors in their telex dated 10.02.87 advised that this ship had been purchased by INTERTRANS SHIPPING for reactivation for one last voyage for scrap, the flag being changed from Bugarian to Maltese for the voyage.

The new Owners wish to reclass this ship with this Society for the proposed voyage:-

- VARNA - PIRAEUS - INDIA for discharge and demolition.

it being concluded that the ship is presently classed with the Bulgarian Register (details of current survey status with the B.R. not presently available in H.Q.)\*

Submitted that the Piraeus Surveyors be informed that, for reclassification with this Society, the following matters will first require attention:-

1. A complete Special Survey in accordance with requirements for a vessel of this age, including T.D.
2. Annual and Docking Surveys in conjunction with the Special Survey.
3. Any major repairs or alterations, which may have been carried out to the structure during the period the ship has been out of class, are to be specially examined in order to ascertain the character of workmanship and to confirm that the scantlings and materials are in accordance with the Rules.
