1. Watertight steel hatch cover of tonnage hatch removed and replaced by temporary wooden hatch covers. ✓

2. Scuppers from tonnage space opened and remote controlled screw down non return valves reconnected to operate from shelter deck. ✓

3. Rubber packing removed from tonnage opening closing plates between tonnage space and tween deck space. Alternate hook bolts omitted from the above closing plates. ✓

4. Loadline marks for closed shelterdeck condition ^{obliterated and} painted out. Hard stopping removed from loadline marks for open shelterdeck condition and marks repainted. ✓
