The Committee decided in February 1944 to omit the class of this vessel from the reprint of the Register Book in view of the fact that she was then in Occupied Territory.

The Surveyor at SPLIT reports (9.46) this vessel placed in dry dock, the requirements of a PERIODICAL SPECIAL SURVEY (D) complied with, and repairs effected to shell and deck plating, frames, side stringers, rudder, and minor items.

The shell plating drilled with results as above, which, with renewals, are satisfactory.

The Surveyor points out that the Poop and Bridge have now been combined, openings in ship's side closed, and aft hatch trunked from the Poop and Bridge deck to the Upper deck. This will necessitate alteration in the Register Book.

It is submitted, in accordance with the Committee's decision of the 9th August regarding surveys held during enemy occupation, the vessel is worthy to have her character reinstated in the Register Book, with record of docking survey 10.46, and to have notation of 'S.S. Ssk. - 10.46 (Dr)' assigned as recommended.
