Many thanks for your letter of the 10th February on the discharge of the above ship.

If the galley is on "D" deck, it will be in order for you to accept two automatic storm valves on each scupper, the uppermost valve being accessible at all times.

I take it that if water got past the storm valve from the sewage tank discharges, it could not penetrate the system beyond the pump. If this is so, there is no need to extend the rods to above "C" deck.
