This vessel damaged by fire was considered a constructive total loss.

A Special Survey for Reclassification has now been carried out.

Docking. All four screwshafts withdrawn and examined. Both inner screwshafts renewed on account of renewing liners. All stern bushes and four propellers renewed. Several new shipside connections fitted.

Main and auxiliary machinery completely opened out and reconditioned.

All main boilers opened out, examined and reconditioned.

Electrical installation renewed in part. All tested.

Parts renewed throughout as necessary. Installation fitted and tested in accordance with the Rules.

IT IS SUBMITTED that this vessel is eligible for the record ~~at~~ LMC 8.50, Port and starboard outer S 10.49, Port and starboard inner, S N 10.49.
