With reference to the case of the above named vessel, I am in receipt of Dr. Webster's letter of the 6th instant furnishing his comments in the matter which are concurred in, and I have to request that you will be guided accordingly.

I would take this opportunity to remark that Dr. Webster was informed on the 15th December that in the event of the ship being prepared for the then contemplated voyage, specimens of the H.E. steel from the topsides should be tested in order to ensure that the properties of the material have not been unduly affected by heat and water, and this provision, of course, still applies.
