In reply to your letter of the 4th instant, I have to state that the recommendations set forth in my letter of the 6th December are considered sufficient for the voyage to U.S.A., provided special consideration be given to Item 9 (pillaring girders and cross ties), and it is also recommended that the vessel be ballasted so that it will have an easy roll.

I might add that it will be advantageous to burn away the damaged superstructure, as suggested.

The contents of your letter have been conveyed to the Leith Surveyors by telephone, and a copy, together with a copy of this letter, has been forwarded to them.

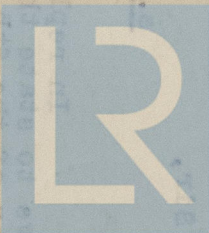
