I enclose herewith copy of a letter dated 28th ultimo received from Messrs. Furness, Withy & Co. together with the deferred reports in the case of the quadruple screw steamer "MONARCH OF BERMUDA".

Attached to the letter you will see a copy of an endorsement prepared in the case by the Ship and Engineer Reports' Departments recommending that the Leith Surveyors should be given certain instructions for compliance before the Writers' request for a certificate of seaworthiness to proceed to the Mediterranean can be granted.

Seeing that the case is rather unusual and that the vessel's class was expunged from the Register Book in June last with a casualty notation of "Burnt - Laid Up", the Chairman of Classification requests that you will arrange for the matter to be attended to by the Leith Surveyors under your direct instructions.
