The Undersigned surveyor to this Corporation, did at the request of the Admiralty, attend the works of Messrs. Babcock & Wilcox Ltd., Glasgow, on September 2, 1943, and subsequently, to survey during construction and hydraulic test, two watertube boilers, Admiralty three type, designated Works Nos. 10/1650, Nos. 15 and 16, and installed on the survey of Lloyd's Register of Shipping in J.1860, built by Messrs. Lithgows Ltd., Port Glasgow.

The material has been tested by the surveyors to the British Corporation, the boiler scantlings are in accordance with the approved specification for a working pressure of 225 lbs/in.², and the workmanship is satisfactory.

The parts of the contract which have been supplied to the builders - viz., boilers, uptakes, furnace fronts and mountings - are found to be satisfactory and in accordance with the approved specification.
