the undersigned Surveyor to this Society did at the request of Messrs. J. & E. Hall, Ltd., Dartford, Kent, attend at their works on the 26th & 30th October and the 9th November, 1933, for the purpose of examining and testing three heater coils, two heater casings, one preheater coil, one air vessel and one suction filter made to the order of Messrs. Todd Oil Burners, Ltd., London, and intended for Messrs. Alex. Stephen & Sons, Ltd., for their No. 538.

The parts have been subjected in the presence of the Undersigned to the following hydraulic tests:-

3 heater coils	500 lbs. per square inch.
2 heater casings	500 lbs. per square inch.
1 preheater coil	500 lbs. per square inch.
1 air vessel	500 lbs. per square inch.
1 suction filter	200 lbs. per square inch.

All the above withstood the tests applied and were found suitable for a working oil pressure of 200 lbs. per square inch with the exception of the suction filter which is suitable for a working pressure of 100 lbs. per square inch.

Each part has been stamped for identification purposes with the test pressure, and with the initials of the Undersigned.
