With reference to your First Entry Report No.48713 on the motorship "COXWOLD", Messrs. Goole S.B. & R. Co's Yard No.330, I have to request you will furnish me with the dimensions of suction connected to both main bilge pumps and auxiliary pumps, as these particulars have been omitted from the report.

I have further to inform you it would appear that the arrangements shown on plans No.3303, embodying the machinery piping arrangement as fitted, differ from the approved plan in the following respects, viz:-

1. The starboard bilge suction to the hold are not provided with non-return valves as required by Section 34, Clause 6(a).
2. Straight tail pipes led from mud boxes are not fitted as required by Section 34, Clause 6(g) and as previously indicated by the Builders on the approved plan of General Pumping Arrangement.
3. The size of bilge suction pipe No.36 is 3" instead of 3½" as required by the Rules.
