This ship has been under survey at SPEZIA

on 2ND JULY TO 10TH SEPTEMBER 1954 and the following alterations to the conditions of assignment of loadlines have now been effected/~~found~~:-

PARTICULARS OF AIR PIPES ON SHELTER DECK:

4 - 104 mm dia. 450 mm coaming goose neck air pipes to new O.F. bunkers and settling tanks now fitted abaft tonnage openings. These goose neck air pipes are provided with wire gauze diaphragms and canvas covers.

PARTICULARS OF PROTECTION TO OPENINGS, ETC.:

HATCHWAYS ON FREEBOARD DECK. : hatchway to ex-coal bunker permanently closed.

Four hatchways to ^{new} O.F. bunkers and settling tanks, 540 x 440 mm, coaming 230 mm. high, now fitted in way, provided with O.T. steel covers.

Plan with Rpt 8. Genoa 20238.

PARTICULARS OF OPENINGS IN THE SIDES. Ash shoot now removed and relative opening in the ship's side permanently closed.
