
This ship has been under survey at Gdynia

on 22-nd November, 1962 ~~1963~~ and the following alterations to the conditions ofassignment of loadlines have now been effected/~~found~~:-


On account of the Conversion from C.S.D. to O.S.D.

the following items have been dealt with :-

1. Scuppers of tonnage well and 'tweendeck spaces draining to the bilges made controllable from shelterdeck. Open/shut indicators fitted.
2. Tonnage hatch steel cover removed and wooden covers secured from below with hemp lashings fitted.
3. Tweendeck bulkhead tonnage opening portable steel plate rubber jointing removed.
4. Hatches and closing appliances on freeboard deck examined and found satisfactory.
5. Freeboard marks for O.S.D. condition painted and verified. C.S.D. condition marks obliterated.
6. A short term L.L. Certificate valid until 22-nd May, 1963 has been handed to the Master.
