Dear Sirs,

S. I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 2nd instant respecting the Motorships "SMOLNY" and "FELIX DZERJINSKY", from which it is noted that Messrs. Sovtorgflot no longer desire to retain the classification of these vessels in the Society's Register Book.

The cases have received the consideration of the Committee at their meeting to-day, and in view of your intimation instructions have been given for the class of each vessel to be withdrawn from the Register Book and three dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.

I have to add that in view of the withdrawal of the classes of these vessels, the records of the freeboards assigned by the Committee, together with the corresponding draughts will also be withdrawn, and the freeboard certificates are thereby cancelled and should be returned to this Office.
