I have surveyed the above ship in accordance with the Rules for Damage & Temporary Repairs, and Drydocking.

The items now surveyed are detailed on this report. All were found or placed in good condition unless otherwise stated.

Damage :- (Cause, time and place not stated)

Found and now done for Damage:- (Temporary Repairs)

Rudder shaft coupling:-

All coupling bolts slightly slackened and sign of coupling faces working.
 In order to avoid delay the Owners' representative's request to defer permanent repairs until the next Special Survey was acceded to, only the following temporary repairs being effected at this time:-

Coupling bolts tightened and bolt heads and nuts secured from turning by welding.

I recommend that this ship remain as classed with/~~without~~ fresh record of dry docking 7/64, subject to rudder shaft coupling and indented shell plate N°5 from forward, p.s., in the 5th strake below sheer being specially examined and dealt with as necessary at the next Special Survey, or before the end of December 1964/// (6 months limit), and, to any other conditions at present attached to her Class being dealt with as previously recommended.



It is further recommended that the following item be entered in the S.R.L.:-

"Rudder shaft coupling and N°5 plate from fwd. in 5th strake below main sheer to be specially examined and dealt with as necessary at the next Special Survey, or, before the end of December 1964."


