"ADAMA" & "PEGASUS BARGE TRAIN".

With reference to Notice No. 2193 we enclose a letter received from the Owners of the above tug and barges requesting that they be surveyed on a continuous basis for the Hull Special Survey.

It is recommended that the Owner's request be given favourable consideration as their operating schedules would be less liable to upset with a longer annual docking period as against the extended period required to complete the 4 years Special Survey.

With reference to the Owners suggestion to deal with the barge train survey by the examination of two complete barges each year, say one end and one centre barge from "Pegasus 1, to 8", it is suggested that this should be adopted as the limited slipway facilities make the examination of the whole train a lengthy procedure at Special Survey periods.

Barges 9, 10, 11, and 12 could also be dealt with on a similar basis, the arrangements for these being worked out after the first Special Survey of barges 11 and 12.

Drawings of all the above craft are enclosed for your records, the red lines on the "ADAMA" drawing indicating the boundaries of each annual survey.
