We are obliged for your letter of the 13th instant reminding us that the Annual Load Line Survey on the above vessel will become due on the 5th December next. It is our present intention to stop this vessel for drydocking, annual overhaul, special survey etc. in February next and we shall carry out the Load Line Survey concurrently with this other work. Unfortunately it is not yet decided whether the vessel will drydock in U.K. or abroad.

s.s. "SNOWCRETE" D

The Load Line Survey on this vessel which becomes due on 2nd January next will be carried out as near as possible to the due date at a North-East coast port.

s.s. "SULFACRETE" D

Negotiations are presently in progress for the sale of this vessel and should these prove successful then the Load Line Survey will devolve upon the new Owners. Should the sale not go through, however, then we shall arrange for the Survey to be carried out on or about the due date.
