Motorship "ST. JAMES"

I am obliged to you for your letter of the 8th December and note the position.

In view of the fact that the Special Survey in this instance became due so long ago as January, 1949, and that no arrangements are contemplated for holding this inspection the Committee consider that the time has arrived when even the severely restricted form of class at present appearing against this vessel's name in the Register Book should not be continued. In common with other cases in a similar category they have, therefore, given instructions for the class to be omitted and a notation of ("Classed LR until 1.49") to be recorded in the next reprint of the Register Book.

Instructions have also been given for similar action to be taken in the case of the motor tankers "FLORIDA" and "RHODE ISLAND". In the case of the "FLORIDA" the notation will be "Classed LR until 3.56" and in the "RHODE ISLAND" "Classed LR until 11.55".
