the Owners' Representative (Atlantic Shipping Agencies, 275 Sherbrooke Street East, Montreal) attend on board the Steel Single Screw Steamer "OAKMOUNT", 2883 Tons Gross Register of Montreal, on the 2nd September, 1947 and subsequent dates for the purpose of examining, testing and witnessing running tests of ONE (1) 7 1/2" x 5" x 6" Horizontal Duplex Steam Pump installed as an oil transfer pump.

The PUMP was manufactured by Worthington Pump and Machinery Corporation, Harrison, New Jersey, U.S.A., Serial No. 132,508.

The Steam cylinder and liquid end were opened up, examined and respectively hydrostatically tested to 450 lbs. and 200 lbs. per square inch, proven sound and tight and stamped.

The PUMP was afterwards assembled and proven satisfactory under working conditions.
