A report of survey carried out during last month has been received from the Society's Surveyors at Antwerp, from which it is noted that the vessel was examined whilst afloat on account of damage stated to have been caused by contact with a bridge at the entrance to Antwerp Docks.

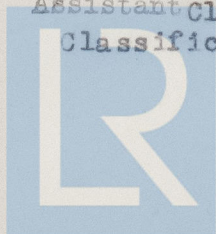
I shall be glad if you will advise the Owners that as a result of this inspection the Committee have continued the vessel's class subject to set in sheer-strake and strake below abreast forward end of No. 1 hatch (port side forward) and structure in way being further examined and dealt with as necessary by the end of this month.

I would refer you to your memorandum of the 5th September in which it is stated that the Special Survey which became due in March last was to be completed by the present time, and, in the absence of further information, I shall be glad to learn how the matter now stands.
