Co. attend at their plant at Curtis Bay, Baltimore, on 10th February 1957 and subsequently for the purpose of examining a Liberty type single plate rudder, fitted with $\frac{1}{4}$ " stainless steel sleeve on main piece in way of steadiment bearing, constructed by the Maryland S.B. & D.D. Co. for stock purposes and in accordance with their approved drawing No. H. S. 584 Alt. C and on their Order No. 71110.

The main stock and pintle forgings are stamped LLOYDS PHL 6578 RK 4-10-56 and LLOYDS PHL 6580 RK 4-10-56 respectively.

The rudder was examined during construction and in a finished condition, the workmanship and materials found good and free from surface defects.

This rudder is in my opinion, suitable for installation in a vessel classed or contemplating class in this Society.

For identification purposes the rudder is now stamped LLOYDS BAL 569 D.H.M. 18-2-57.
