13462 "BALLYGALLY HEAD". As recommended, except that the machinery class has also been continued subject as previously recorded, to the propeller being examined and dealt with as necessary at the next drydocking.

13465 "BENMACDHUI". As recommended.

I shall be glad to learn whether the auxiliary boiler fuel tank on the platform deck (port side) forms part of the main structure, in which case you should clarify its position in the ship, as this is not shown on the plans available in this Office.

13425 "IWTA JAMUNA".) The contents of your
13424 "IWTA MEGHNA".) reports have been noted, and these ships will be eligible to be classed +A.1 "River and Estuary Service" together with the appropriate notations, when reports have been received of their satisfactory condition upon arrival in the service area.

I have to inform you that the approved plans should accompany your Rpt.1 for each ship, the plans being returned to you in due course for use in connection with each sister ship and that "As Built" Plans should be stamped and signed in accordance with Instructions to Surveyors, Part 2a, 1950, Amendment No.8.
