
ENDORSEMENTS OF CLASS (B).

Sheerstrake plates Nos. 4 & 5 and Nos. 6, 7, & 8 in 1st below sheer (p.s.) indented.

Keel and bottom shell plating in 'A' and 'B' strakes (p & s), also side plating on waterline (p & s) slightly wavy.
