Dear Sirs,

H. I have to acquaint you that to complete the Special Survey of the hull which became due in November, 1948 in the case of the Steamer "ALASKA PRINCE" the following items remain to be examined, namely :-

Oil fuel bunker, oil fuel tank aft of chain locker, port and starboard side tanks (fish oil), fore peak (reserve oil tank), and engine and boiler room double bottom tanks.

The machinery requirements have been complied with.

The validity of the Load Line Certificate will expire on the 28th proximo and a Load Line Renewal Survey will require to be held in conjunction with the completion of the Special Survey. The Annual Classification Survey will become due at the end of next month.

In the circumstances I shall be glad if you will ascertain from the Owners and let me know what arrangements they propose making to carry out the outstanding inspections.
