With reference to reports on this ship dated Vancouver B.C., May 2, 1949, according to the records at this office the following items still remain to be dealt with in order to complete the special survey and you might please confirm that these are in accordance with the surveyor's notes:-

- Examination and test of oil fuel bunkers.
- Examination and test of fore peak tank (reserve oil tank)
- Examination and test of double bottom tank under engine and boiler.
- Examination of fuel oil tank aft of chain locker.
- Examination of port and starboard side tanks.
- Test of aft peak tank.
- Examination of holding down bolts.
- Examination of auxiliary condenser.
- Examination of evaporator.
- Examination of EL circuits and megger test of wiring.

Please forward particulars of drillings of shell and deck plating.
