M.V. "TIO PEPE"

Further to my memorandum of the 28th. February 1952 advising you that the above vessel had been an collision in the Guadalquivir River (Sevilla) and was partly submerged, I have now to inform you that our latest information regarding the vessel is that part of the cargo was salvaged and the vessel beached for temporary repairs to allow her to be towed to Matagorda for docking etc.

Unfortunately whilst the River was in flood the vessel disappeared and was found three days later completely submerged about three miles down river, but clear of navigation.

Lloyd's Agent who supplied the above information stated that salvage operation will be started in the next few days.

LLOYD'S AGENT WHO SUBMITTED THE ABOVE INFORMATION STATED THAT SALVAGE OPERATIONS WOULD BE STARTED IN THE NEXT FEW DAYS. ABOUT THREE MILES DOWN RIVER, BUT GREAT OF NAVIGATION. DISAPPEARED AND WAS FOUND THREE DAYS LATER COMPLETELY SUBMERGED. UNFORTUNATELY WHILE THE RIVER WAS IN FLOOD THE VESSEL

TO RECOMMENDS FOR DOCKING ETC.

VESSEL REACHED FOR TEMPORARY REPAIRS TO ALLOW HER TO BE TOWED THE VESSEL IS THAT PART OF THE CARGO WAS SALVAGED AND THE I HAVE NOW TO INFORM YOU THAT OUR LATEST INFORMATION REGARDING THE GUNDELFING RIVER (SEVILLA) AND WAS PARTLY SUBMERGED. ADVISING YOU THAT THE ABOVE VESSEL HAD BEEN IN COLLISION IN FURTHER TO MY MEMORANDUM OF THE 28TH. FEBRUARY 1925
