Rule Dimensions:- 416' x 56'10 $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 37.4' to upper dk.
28.7' to second dk.

Class:- 100A1 With a freeboard corresponding
to a moulded draught of 26'10"
with the notations "Electrically
welded" and "Collision bulkhead
to shelter deck, six W.T. bulkheads
to second deck, six divisional W.T.
bulkheads in shelter tween decks".

This ship is one of the 60 sister ships being
built in America to the order of the British Government, and the
remarks in the Memorandum, dated 26th January 1942, dealing
with the "OCEAN VANGUARD" apply equally to the present case.
