Memorandum of alterations reported since ship was surveyed for assignment of Load Lines in *MAY 1955 AT BREMERHAVEN.*

THE DOUBLE BOTTOM TANKS NOS. 1, 2, 3, 4, 7 AND 8 ARE CONVERTED TO CARRY OIL FUEL, A COFFERDAM BETWEEN D.B. TANK 6 (FEED WATER) AND 7 (OIL FUEL) AND TWO SETTLING TANKS HAVE BEEN FITTED THIS TIME. ALL NEW AIR PIPES FOR THE ABOVE OIL FUEL TANKS ARE OF SUBSTANTIAL CONSTRUCTION, HEIGHT OF OPENINGS = 36" ABOVE DECK. ALL NEW AND EXISTING AIR PIPES FOR THE OIL FUEL TANKS AND COFFERDAM ARE FITTED WITH WIRE GAUZE DIAPHRAGMS AND EFFECTIVE CLOSING APPLIANCES.
