10,000 Ton Cargo Vessels.

We have been advised by the shipbuilders that the names of two vessels building locally have been changed as follows:-

<u>Hull No.</u>	<u>Originally</u>	<u>Now</u>
534	"FORT LA PRAIRIE"	"PRINCE ALBERT PARK"
535	"FORT MISTASSINI"	"GATINEAU PARK"

Would you be good enough to confirm these changes with W.M.S.L. and request that in future we receive advice at the same time as the Yard. In the case of the former vessel, all Freeboard Reports and Certificates have been forwarded to New York and are probably now in the mail for Wokingham, therefore, both these offices should be advised before the Freeboard Certificate and Certified Copy are prepared.
