I thank you for your letter of the 5th instant, and it is agreed that the moulded depth of this ship to uppermost continuous deck is 37'-6" and to second deck 28'-6". The figure to be shown in the Register Book, Volume II, will be 28'-6" but I shall be glad if you will let me know which figure is desired on the Classification Certificate, bearing in mind the possibility of this ship being changed to closed shelterdecker at a subsequent date. It is concluded that the depth of 37'-6" was verified from the ship, but I shall be glad if you will confirm this.
