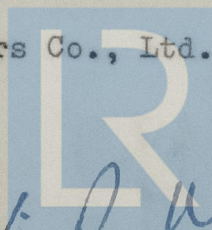
According to our present records no part of the Special Survey has yet been held either on the hull or on the engines.
