Dear Sirs

The steamer "MODUM" has left here for your port where the machinery will be installed.

The sea connections were completed in dry dock and examined complete on the 25th. of February. The stern tube is fitted and was examined on the 29th. of November 1920.

The Cargo pumps have been installed and cargo lines fitted and tested by hydraulic pressure of 100 lbs, but the pipe chairs and valve rods are not complete.

The cargo heating pipes in Nos. 1, 2 and 3 tanks and oil fuel bunker D.B. are complete and have been tested to 300 lbs. hydraulic pressure; the remaining tanks and the deck connections to all tanks will be completed at Newcastle and the necessary tests made.

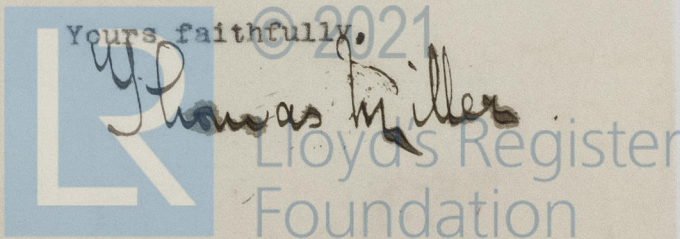
