

TO BE KEPT ON TOP OF CASE

Nylon Sheaves for Cargo Blocks

Messrs. H.J. Jacobsens Eftf., Svendborg, Denmark.

The Copenhagen Surveyors were instructed on the 15th February, 1963, to inform Messrs. H.J. Jacobsens Eftf., Svendborg, that blocks having nylon sheaves made by them will be provisionally approved for use with manilla or similar natural fibre ropes on ships classed by the Society, including those cases where the Society is certifying the cargo gear.

Final approval will depend on the sheaves being found satisfactory after one year in service.

The Copenhagen Surveyors now state in their letter of the 26th November that such blocks with nylon sheaves have been fitted on board the following vessels:-
