This is to Certify that

the undersigned Surveyor to this Society did at the request of Messrs. Stewarts and Lloyds Ltd., attend at their Bromford Works, on the 13th and 17th July, 1962 for the purpose of inspecting and testing tubes to the order of Aalborg Vaerft A/S.

- 35 - 7.1/2" o.d. x 5.4mm thk. x 5/6metres = 678'10"
- 9 - 12.1/2" o.d. x 8mm thk. x 5/6metres = 175'2"

Hot finished seamless Steel tubes, have been examined internally and externally, gauged and all found satisfactory and in accordance with the terms of the order. The ends of the tubes were not ground.

The material from which the tubes were manufactured was made at an approved steel works and material tests were carried out on the finished tubes with satisfactory results in accordance with DIN 17175, Grade 1, matl., St.35.8 and terms of the order.

All tubes have been hydraulically tested by the manufacturers to 1140 p.s.i. and 10% of these tests were witnessed by the Surveyor with satisfactory results. The manufacturers' certificate of 100% hydraulic test was accepted.

For the purpose of identification the tubes were stamped near one end:- HF.
