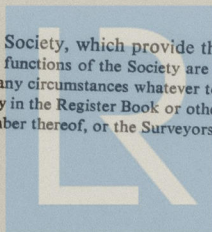
M.S. "BIJSK"

This is to certify that the hull of the M.S. "BIJSK", 10,684 tons gross of ODESSA has been surveyed by us during construction by Messrs. Nakskov Skibeverft at Nakskov (their yard No. 172) and was found, on the above date, to be in accordance with the approved plans and Society's Rules, Regulations and requirements.

A report is being forwarded to the Committee of Lloyd's Register of Shipping, London, recommending that the ship be classed + 100 A.1 (Ice Class III).
