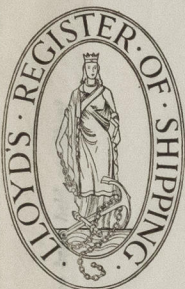

*condition in respect of 4" tubes of starboard boiler.*

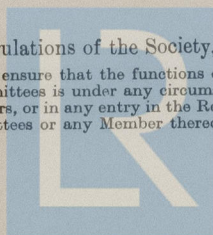
