Dear Sir,

It is with regret that I forward a copy of a letter from Messrs. Tsavlis (Hellas) Maritime Co. advising us of the withdrawal of twelve ships from the Society's class.

I have discussed this matter with Mr. Tsavlis with whom we are on good terms and can assure you that, there is no question of dissatisfaction with the Society's services. The four cargo vessels are however known to us to be in need of fairly extensive repairs and Mr. Tsavlis, being a pragmatist, has elected to take these ships to where he believes the requirements for repairs will be a minimum.

The condition of the tugs is not known to us, these vessels never having come under our survey, but I understand that the same reasoning has governed his decision with regard to these latter vessels.
