Memorandum of alterations reported since ship was surveyed for assignment of Load Lines in _____

The tonnage opening and all overboard scuppers from the shelter tween deck spaces (except scupper in tonnage well) have been permanently closed as a wartime measure. Suitable provision has been made for rigging lifelines.

The necessary drainage holes have been cut in the shelter tween deck bulkheads.

The freeboards have been reassigned and are now measured from the shelter deck, the markings have been verified and cut in on sides of vessel.

(The water tight bulkheads have not been extended to the shelter deck at this time.)
