fuel oil burning. The Todd oil burning unit No 2164 (London certificate D 350/4.) now fitted on board in accordance with the ved plan (Eng letter 22-4-54) tested the suction and delivery lines by hydr pressure as required and found tight, while all connections of the Gen. Service pump with the feed lines were blanked. Also removed all the lead connections of the bilge lines and replaced same by steel.

Leaving coils fitted into the bunkers and setting tanks, tested by air pressure and steam, as required and found tight.

Found the sounding pipes of the settling tanks fitted in the stokehold instead of in the settling tank but without valves against the bulkhead, while there was an opportunity to fit mentioned valves now recommended to fit closing valves to these sounding pipes.
