I acknowledge receipt of your letter of the 17th instant, the contents of which have been noted.

The Certificates forwarded by you are only acceptance Certificates issued by the East German Authorities for surveys which were carried out by this Society's Surveyors in October 1960.

The Certificate signed by the Chief Engineer on board, covering the adjustment of evaporator and exhaust gas boiler safety valves, will be accepted, but the oil fired boiler safety valves must be adjusted by the East German Classification Surveyor, and a copy of his Certificate sent to this Office.

It is noted that the ship is now trading between East German ports, and I shall be glad if you will let me know what arrangements you propose to make to enable the Society's Surveyors to carry out future periodical surveys.
