I duly received your letter of the 15th February regarding the survey of the machinery and auxiliary boilers of this ship and, in reply, I have to say that the Committee will not object to the safety valves of the exhaust gas economiser being adjusted by the Chief Engineer, and I shall be obliged if you will arrange for his Certificate covering this adjustment to be forwarded to this office.

As regards the safety valves of the oil fired boilers and the evaporator, I have to say that the Committee expect this work to be done under the inspection of a Surveyor to this Society, and I shall be glad if you will arrange accordingly. Perhaps you will be so good as to let me know when and at what port this inspection can be carried out.
