Memorandum of alterations reported since ship was surveyed for assignment of Load Lines in May, 1944.

ALTERATIONS:

Now Done:- Two 12 inch cowl ventilators fitted on Upper Deck, one to Butcher's Shop, Port side, and one to Dry Store Spaces, Starboard side in the 'tween decks amidship; coamings 10'-2" high x .40" thick, efficiently stayed to Boat Deck and fitted with wood plugs and canvas covers.
