With reference to Sunderland First Entry Report No. 31983 on the Machinery of the steamer "GENERTON" I regret to inform you that the donkey boiler of this vessel was erroneously described as an auxiliary boiler.

I have therefore to request that the report be amended in respect of this, which will also entail the alteration of the nominal horse power from 408 to 359. ✓

The fee for the donkey boiler will now be £9. 4. 0. and the First Entry Fee £78.17. 0.

An amended account will be rendered to the Builders and the Owners have been requested to return the Machinery Classification Certificate for correction.
