M.V. "NORDIC":

In reply to your letter of the 2nd January regarding the port main engine scavenge pump - repaired and surveyed at Aden, 26th/29th November last - we would advise that as it was not opportune to have the unit re-examined at Liverpool, at our request your Glasgow Office effected the survey on the vessel's arrival at the latter port.

The replacement parts, on order with the Engine Builders, will not be available before the vessel is required to sail on her forthcoming round voyage to Australian ports and back to the U.K., and it would therefore be appreciated if the Committee would accede to deferment of the permanent repair until the termination of the voyage, or, say for a period of six months, with present Class maintained.
