I am obliged to you for your letter of 4th instant.

The circumstances have been considered by the Committee today, and they have decided immediately to suspend the vessel's class by the assignment of a Notation of "Repairs required - class suspended".


In actual fact, the Committee feel the ship is worthy of having her class withdrawn owing to reported defects, but they wish the Owner to be advised of this likelihood before they take such drastic action.

Will you, therefore, kindly write to the Owner stating that the class will be withdrawn on 21st instant, unless a satisfactory assurance is received from him before that date that he will carry out the overdue Special Survey and all necessary repairs under your inspection and to your satisfaction. Meantime, pending the receipt of a definite notification from him as to his intentions regarding maintenance of class, the class has been suspended owing to the repairs that are outstanding.
